Dear Friend of Liberty!

Our Libertarian Party has wonderful opportunities. The Republican war party and its Democratic allies have discredited themselves. On issue after issue, from ending the War On Iraq to Medical Marijuana, the American people agree with our answers.

To build a winning Libertarian Party, we need to do everything right. We need strong local organization. We need good local candidates. We need Libertarian affinity groups. **And we need an effective flagship campaign, because many Americans only notice one political race, and that only for a few weeks every four years.**

To move us toward the libertarian future, I have agreed to run for our Party's Presidential nomination. **Phillies 2008 is here to provide that effective flagship campaign.** I'm building a strong volunteer effort, recruiting people who will stay with us when the election is over. I'm building local and affinity groups. Most important, I'm running on sensible issues that the American people actually care about: Iraq. Social Liberties. 3E: Education, Energy, and the Environment. Stagnant wages.

I'm running as ***the serious man for serious times***, the man as trustworthy as your grandfather's banker. My doctorate is in physics. It's from MIT. There are no scandals in my past. Open my closets: No skeletons will fall out.

How will I campaign?

I'll spend your money on real politics, not on fancy real estate or overpriced consultants. This is 2007: I'm only paying people for time-critical activities: My Treasurer. My Webmaster. My Chief of Staff, Charles Wilhoit, is a full-time unpaid volunteer.

I'll emphasize electronic outreach. Electronic media like MySpace and YouTube cost almost nothing. They create word of mouth. Web pages and blog ads are already running.

I'll give voters our good libertarian answers, answers that are sensible and work in the real world. I'll give answers that bring voters to our side, not scream in-your-face-foolishness that terrifies normal people.

I'll be accessible to you, our potential 2008 delegates. I'm traveling to state convention after

state convention, giving my speech and meeting the real Libertarians who will choose our next Presidential candidate.

I'm working for ballot access. I've given my staff a clear goal: Our Libertarian Presidential candidate shall be on the ballot in every single state. I'm prepared to spend \$350,000 from my campaign funds, up to 20% of every dollar raised, to reach this goal.

I'm already supporting volunteer activists. The Libertarian Candidate campaign support disk has been distributed to hundreds of potential party leaders. Myspace, Facebook, and historical volunteer records are finding Phillies 2008 supporters and bringing them together, town by town, from sea to shining sea.

Build Our Party: Support Activists

In 2008, you have a choice: You can support a candidate with a weak campaign and exotic campaign nostrums. Or you can support a candidate who is **a real Libertarian, a long-time party member with real campaign organization, a real record of professional achievement, and real issues that appeal to most Americans.** I hope that you prefer *reality*, because *reality* is the choice I am offering you.

I'm investing personally in my own campaign. For all of 2008, I'll campaign full time. To do that, I'm taking a year's leave of absence from my job. That's a sacrifice I am delighted to make for our country and our party.

Libertarian Presidential campaigns are not one-man shows. The candidate does his part: He asks friends for their time and money--that's what I'm doing here. He asks the public for their votes. Above all, he sells Liberty to the American people. That's why I'm already running public advertising.

But a lone candidate won't go anywhere. A successful campaign needs volunteers and money.
