There simply is no alternative: We need an authentic Libertarian Party Presidential campaign. We need an authentic Libertarian Party candidate to carry our banner.

I'm George Phillies. And I'm an authentic Libertarian. I was State Party Executive Director in 1996. I ran for Congress in 1998. I'm our Massachusetts State Chair. And I'm already bringing you an authentic campaign. Authentic?

I'm winning delegates. Libertarian delegates aren't the robots seen at Democratic and Republican conventions. Our delegates actually choose our Presidential candidate. How do you win delegate support? You travel from state to state so potential delegates can meet you.

I travel. I've been to New Hampshire, Florida, New York, New Jersey, Pennsylvania, Maryland, Rhode Island, Georgia, Alabama, Tennessee, Ohio, Louisiana, Nevada, and New Mexico.

I plan appearances in Illinois, Oklahoma, California, Missouri, and many more to come.

Advertising: I'm already advertising. My radio ads are heard in dozens of markets. My Google Adwords campaign has had millions of impressions. That's not counting the BlogAds. Bumper stickers are visible across America. Phillies 2008 press releases are hitting broadcast and print media and the internet. My web pages have had hundreds of thousands of visits.

Primaries: The Presidential primary season is fast approaching. State after state will have non-binding Libertarian Party primaries, every one a great opportunity for free publicity. I will contest them as aggressively as I can.

Money: We're Libertarians. We don't have the huge budgets of our opponents. Our campaigns still cost money. **Face the truth: If someone can't raise money or invest their own money in their Presidential campaign, their campaign is a joke.** Phillies 2008 has already received close to \$50,000. By 1996 or 2000 standards, that's not a lot of cash. But I've spent it very carefully.

Volunteers: How do you succeed when you can't hire a huge staff? The answer is volunteers. A good campaign recruits them, supports them, and uses their talent and hard work to reach the American people. That's what I'm doing. I've done it before. In 2004 I was National Volunteer Coordinator for Aaron Russo and then for Michael Badnarik.

High objectives: Volunteer campaigns don't launch overnight. That's why Phillies 2008 started last year. I have volunteer coordinators and groups for 25 states and D.C, and for media and internet outreach. **My objective is a volunteer effort in every Congressional District.** That's a very ambitious target—prior Libertarian Presidential campaigns viewed state coordinators as their goal.

Ballot access? My campaign is spending money for ballot access. We've already sent \$2500 for matching funds to North Carolina. I've promised up to 20% of my funds raised, up to a third of a million dollars, for 50-state ballot access. That's a third of a million dollars more than any of my Libertarian opponents have promised.

For our party, my ballot access money is critical. There is no choice. Go read the latest LNC minutes. Between the fancy words, you'll find the LNC has effectively given up on West Virginia, D.C., Oklahoma, and South Dakota. If you want a chance of 50 state ballot access, you have only one choice: **Send your money to Phillies 2008. Earmark it for ballot access.**

Vote objectives: 2008 offers a golden opportunity for our party. The Bush Republicans disgraced America. Democrats are afraid to stand up to them. If we Libertarians hang together and support real Libertarian Party candidates, we have a real opportunity to set new records at every level. Harness public disgust at the Bush Republican Party and the Democratic doormats who cower whenever Bush whines, and 2008 will be a banner year for our party.

Now you've read what I'm doing. I'm offering an authentic Libertarian campaign. But to do more. I need your help.
